



## House rules

Welcome to Festival Downtown!

We ask you to:

- Stay or go home if you have any symptoms of illness.
- Wash your hands frequently. There is a facility next to the toilets.
- There is disinfectant available for all visitors next to the entrance, bar, food trucks and toilets.

### General house rules

*In case of any doubt or discussion, the organisation will have final say.*

By buying an entrance ticket and/or entering the festival the visitor accepts the house rules.

Festival Downtown reserves the right to re-evaluate these house rules.

Infringement of these rules might lead to denial of entrance to the festival without any restitution.

### Own risk/ liability

Entering the festival is at your own risk. Festival Downtown doesn't accept any liability for any injuries like hearing damage, visual disturbance, or any form of physical disorder.

### Entrance ticket

Entrance to the festival for the paid locations is granted by showing a valid entrance ticket combined with a valid ID (driver's licence, passport or ID-Card).

### Minimum-age

The festival advises a minimum age of 16 for independently (so unaccompanied by a person of age) visiting the festival.

### Identification requirement

There is a requirement of identification on and during the entire festival (like everywhere in The Netherlands). Accepted identification documents are: drivers licence, Passport or ID-Card.

### Alcohol and tobacco

Visitors younger than 18 are not allowed to buy or consume alcohol or tobacco. It is also not allowed to pass-on alcohol or tobacco to any visitors younger than 18. When asked by crew or security, visitors must show their valid ID.

Smoking is only permitted in the open air. It is NOT allowed to smoke in any (temporary) buildings, constructions, tents and/or canopies.

### Photography, filming and audio recordings

Without explicit consent by crew, it is not permitted to film and or make audio recordings from artist performances at the festival. Only compact cameras without detachable lenses are permitted.

Cameras *with* detachable lenses or SLR cameras are only permitted with explicit consent by crew. Selfiesticks and GoPro's are not permitted. During the festival, the crew is allowed to make photographs or video recordings for promotional purposes without offering any compensation.

### Inappropriate behaviour

Festival Downtown is a safe haven for all. We WILL NOT ACCEPT ANY FORM OF DISCRIMINATION, INTIMIDATION, RUINATION, EXCITON, OR AGGRESION. BE NICE.

Any form of these might and probably will lead to you getting excluded from the festival without any compensation. If we deem necessary, we will also transfer assholes to the police. Graffiti and open fires are forbidden.

If you feel unsafe please contact a crewmember and ask for help.

### Merchandise

It is not permitted to sell any goods or services on the festival without explicit consent by crew. It is not permitted to flyer or hand out any kind of samples.

### (Entrance)check and visitation

At the entrance of the festival personal belongings such as bags and jackets will get checked for forbidden objects. Security will also check visitors by patting clothing, pockets, bags and shoes. Not accepting these checks will lead to exclusion to the festival without any restitution.

### Forbidden objects

If any forbidden objects are found during check, they will be obtained. If deemed appropriate by security or crew, the police will be notified. Confiscated goods will not be returned.

### Class, tin cans and (self-brought) alcoholic beverages

Class, tin cans and (self-brought) alcoholic beverages are not allowed on the festival. Exceptions are made for perfume and necessary medication in original glass packaging (max 50ml).

### These objects are not permitted on the festival:

Self-brought drinks (except water in plastic bottles of no more than 0,5l without a cap), bidons, self-brought foods, any drugs or other stimuli, nitrous oxide, spray cans (except suncreams, deodorant and perfume), refilling for e-cigarettes, provocative or foreconceiving clothing, any objects that could be used as a weapon, laser-pens, toxic, flammable or explosive materials, fireworks, flares, pets, canes (unless you medically need them), chairs or stools.

### These objects are only permitted combined with a medical passport:

Heavy medication, food, liquids necessary for allergies, sickness.
